Club development plans

The future of our Club has been the subject of discussion for many years. Following the members decision to raise funds by selling off the Bowls Green for the refurbishment of the Indoor Arena and in particular to replace the asbestos roof and side walls, progress has been slow and painful at times.

Although nothing is certain in the world of planning and development, some significant progress has been made. The small subcommittee tasked with tackling this minefield has made significant progress. A planning application has now been filed and is awaiting approval.

Should this be successful, we will receive a substantial sum of money which will enable us to proceed to the next stage of the project where we can build a new green, tackle the asbestos situation on the indoor arena and make improvements within the indoor arena.

With money supplied by the developer, we have installed a borehole and this will give us access to free water to use now on the existing green and the new one when constructed. The current green will still be used until the new green is match ready, so there will not be a time when we will be without a playing surface.
